Culture Report: Geranium 'Cassiopeia' By Melanie Byrne

This advancement in the interspecific geranium category has the look of a premium zonal geranium with a habit perfect for baskets and containers.

'Cassiopeia' features large double flowers in a rich, dark, velvet red, which bloom under full sun and partial shade conditions. Its superior branching fills containers quickly, providing a premium finished plant.
